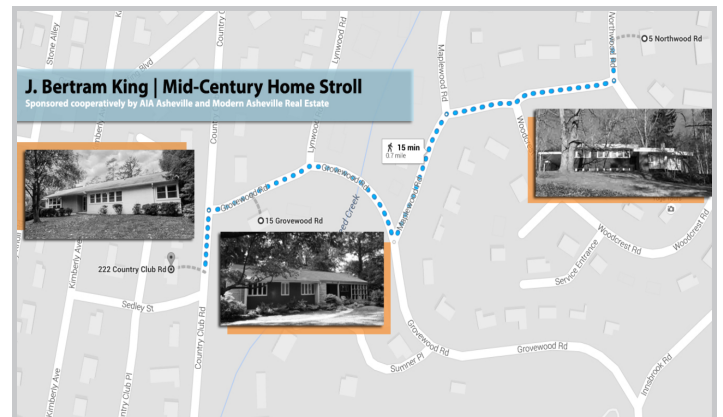


The Ray and Fancella Poston House

Bert designed many residential and commercial structures in the Asheville area. He won an award for his design of the Warren Wilson Chapel. He, also, designed Asheville's downtown Library.
